



CPAANT GENERAL MEETING MINUTES JUNE 5, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 am and our Sgt at Arms led the members and guests in the pledge of allegiance.

June 9th 9am-3pm at the Wal-mart parking lot in Roanoke CPA members are helped the PD officers with child safety seat event.

Burleson: May 5th booth for Cinco de Mayo event for the PD's open house. 5th CPA starts Thursday June 10th. July 10th at City Hall in Burleson is hosting CPANNT meeting. We are having 2 fund raising: 1) A&D for the PD and 2) helping anyone needing assistance to attend the convention called "You Have Been Flocked" program. Where plastic Pink Flamingos are secretly put into a person yard, a person can pay a fee for these 25 birds to be put in that person yards.

Mansfield: Park Patrol with golf cart with 2 members and 2 skywatch towers. Field of Dream- new citizen on Patrol handicap parking program going on June- July.

Eules: The RAD program was a hit and the group is buying their own Red man Suit, the RAD link to Eules link to RAD can be found on CPAANT. CPA fundraiser, Dine Around event at I-Hop got 10% sold and made about \$300.
