



CPAANT GENERAL MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 3, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 10:04 am by President, Geri Sorg. This month's meeting is being hosted by the Arlington Citizen Police Academy Alumni Association. The Arlington Rep welcomed everyone and thanked the ACPAAA members for hosting the meeting.

There were Twenty-seven (27) in attendance with ten (10) CPAANT representatives present. The alumni cities present were Arlington, Euless, Lewisville, Carrollton, Flower Mound, Mesquite, Cedar Hill, Roanoke, Fort Worth, Irving, Mansfield, Coppell, and Weatherford.

This month's guest speakers introduced were Arlington City Councilman Robert Rivera, Deputy Police Chief James Hawthorne, Lt. David Killinger, and Officer Karen Donahue. Detective Tommy LeNoir gave the keynote presentation on solving murders.

Following a short break the meeting began with the pledge of allegiance followed by the approval of the minutes with a motion by Arlington and second by Mesquite to approve them. After reviewing the treasurer's report, a motion was made by Arlington and seconded by Carrollton to accept the treasurer's report.

Carrollton will be hosting the Chief's Roundtable on November 7th. Invitations have been sent and sixteen chiefs have responded. Discussion was brought up to the membership to purchase flash drives as gifts for the chiefs. A motion was made by Mansfield and seconded by Arlington to approve up to \$400 for twenty-five drives and have them imprinted with CPAANT. The motion was approved.

The By-Laws chairperson announced that there would be a committee meeting on October 15th to start the review of CPAANT's By-Laws to bring them into compliance with state and federal laws.

The floor was opened for general and alumni discussion:

CPAANT's webmaster said the web site has had 770 hits.

CPAANT's state rep announced that the state CPAAA is seeking a secretary. There meetings are held quarterly in Buffalo, Tx.

Mansfield is now doing part patrols on their new golf cart.

Weatherford will be holding a fund raising golf tournament on October 18th. They also directed traffic last Thursday when the highway was shut down for an accident.

A motion was made by Arlington and seconded by Coppell to adjourn at 12:40 pm.
